Wedding Dress:

Room Decor & Table Plan:

The Everglades took care of the table and chair décor and provided a starlight backdrop behind the top table. Their room also has mood lighting, you can choose the colour of the light in the room to suit the meal and entertainment. For the table plan, we named the tables after places we have visited together, and Paul made table centres on a CNC machine to represent each place.

Stationary:

Perfect Day Print in Ballymena created our wedding stationary. They were great to work with – from the initial design to making adjustments they made it all so easy for us and I can't thank them enough for the gorgeous stationary we had in the end.

What food you choice & why:
